## WEATHER OUTLOOK

### March 11- April 10

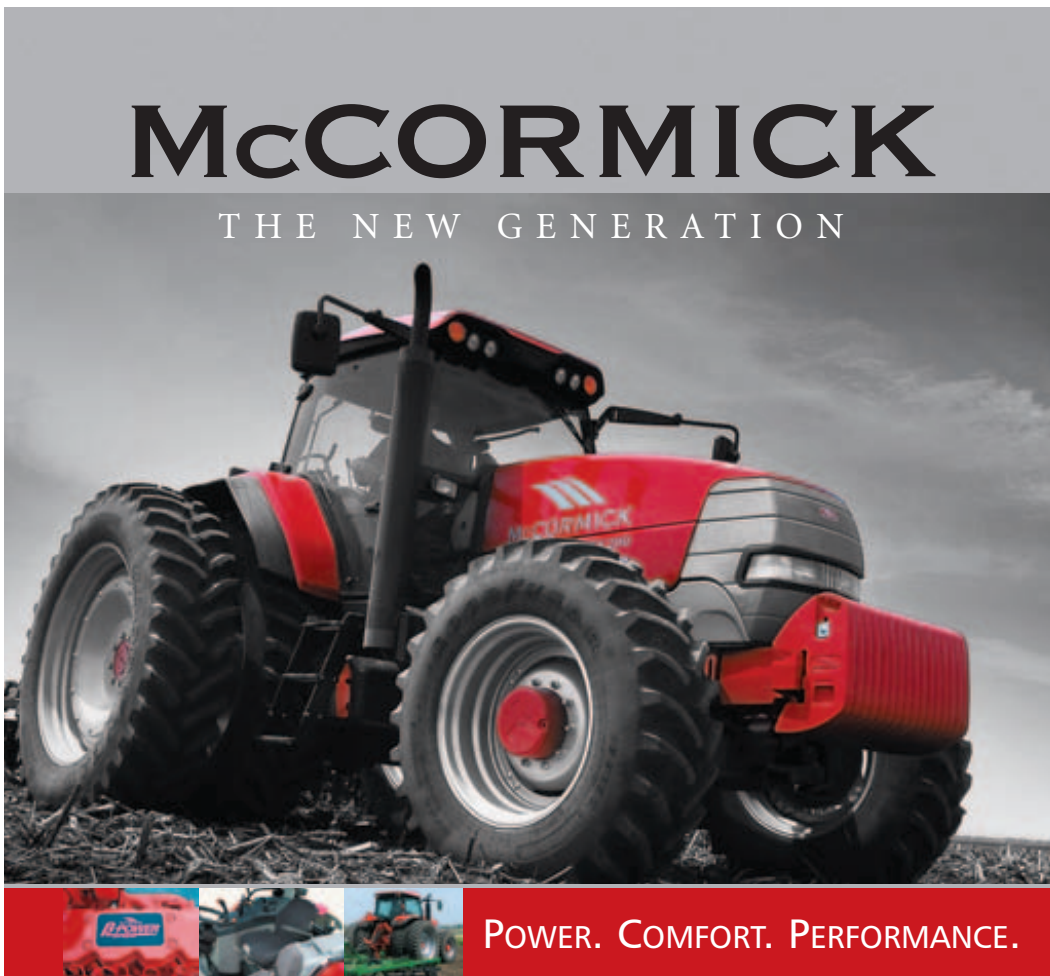
**WEATHERGRAM**  
The last three weeks of April are expected to be cooler and drier than normal.

FOR the March 11-April 10 period, temperatures are favored to average below normal. Precipitation is expected to total near normal over much of North Dakota. Below-normal totals are favored over the western por-

tions of South Dakota. The best prospect for above-normal totals is over the eastern one-third of South Dakota. Fair skies are in store for the Dakotas on March 11 and though the weekend into March 12. Precipitation, if any, should be light. Prospects increase for snow or rain from March 13-17. Locally heavy precipitation totals are expected. Cloudy skies are favored over North

Dakota for the weekend of March 18-19 with scattered light snows possible. South Dakota should enjoy fair skies with a mix of sun and clouds. Dry weather is expected to settle in March 20-23. Clouds are expected to increase on March 24 with good prospects for a late-winter storm for the weekend of March 25-26. Precipitation may start out as rain and change to snow. Clouds and passing precipitation are expected to linger into March 27-28.

Drier skies with a mix of sun and clouds are favored from March 29-31. Expect scattered showers the weekend of April 1-2. Precipitation totals should be light. Fair skies are expected April 3-5. Windy conditions, increasing clouds and frequent shower activity are favored April 6-10. Moderate to locally heavy precipitation totals are possible. *Watson is a White Bear Lake meteorologist.
