Look for wet weather to continue

Weather outlook

TEMPERATURES are favored to be average to near normal. Precipitation is expected to be wetter than normal during this forecast period. Fair skies are favored for May 15-16.

WEATHERGRAM
 June temperatures: Slightly warmer.
 June precipitation: Widespread rains first half with scattered rains second half.

Clouds with passing showers are expected for May 17-18.

After fair skies May 19, showers and thunderstorms are favored for May 20-

21. Locally heavy precipitation totals are expected, especially over North Dakota.

Showers and thunderstorms are expected to persist from May 22-25. Locally heavy precipitation totals with cooling temperatures are expected.

Fair skies with scattered showers are favored for May 26-27.

May 28 to June 4 is expected to be a very wet period. Expect showers and

thunderstorms with locally heavy rainfall totals. Temperatures are expected to be on the cool side.

Look for some sun June 5. Showers and thunderstorms are favored for June 6-7. Fair skies with passing showers are expected from June 8-11. Seasonable temperatures are favored.

Showers and thunderstorms are favored to end the period from June 12-14. Temperatures are favored to be warm.
