

Visit our new Web site

STARTING in late August, visitors to *www.TheFarmer.com* got a little surprise as we fired up our Web site overhaul. The Internet is a fast-changing environment, and our newest redesign aims to offer you quick access to local and national news, weather, and marketing information you need. Then — because we know you need more — we went a step further, giving you opportunities to customize the site to fit your operation. A totally new approach was designed with you as our priority.

The redesigned site offers you the ability to create your own version of a home page that you can visit each day to keep up on the world of agriculture. This feature does require you to register, but is saved for use on any computer (see “Why register?”). We know agriculture isn’t your only pastime, so we offer you the ability to customize the page as well with news from papers in your region, sports stories or even information sources you find yourself.

Drag and drop

At first glance, the new site design shows you several “windowpanes,” each filled with specific information. For example, at the top left you’ll see “Farm Progress News,” which includes local news from this magazine, along with easy one-click access to national ag news, livestock information, and even our “Technology Update” that highlights the latest information on new products and services coming to market.

You’ll find a windowpane for weather, for marketing information and even news from our sister publications *Rural Life* and *Farm Futures*.

The key is that you can make that page look any way you want. Don’t like the weather below markets? Just left-click on the green bar at the top of the pane and then, while holding down the mouse button, drag that pane to another place on the screen.

You’ll also note that each pane has buttons in that top bar for compressing the information, or closing the pane. This feature, which acts like a window shade, allows you to have several panes on the screen at once.

Add more content

You start with a strong base of content — including risk management tools you can’t find anywhere else. Yet you
