

Where to get information, other services

THE Central Iowa Expo has all the services of a miniature city, complete with parking, public transportation, emergency services, public air-conditioned restrooms and more. Here's a quick rundown of where to find these and other services during your visit to the show.



Show office: The heart of operations is the administration building, located just outside the grounds at the south end of Sixth Street on the south side of the exhibit field.

Restrooms: Restrooms are near the entrances and within the four food courts in the center of each quad-

rant of the exhibit field. The northwest and southeast restrooms are air conditioned. See map on Page 37.

First Aid: First aid stations are located at each end of Sixth Street, the east end of Central Avenue and at the east end of South Avenue.

Lost children: If you lose a child, check

the nearest first aid station, information booth or the show office. See map on Page 37.

Lost and found: Lost items will be brought to the show office.

Information booths: These one-stop shops for information not covered in this program or last-minute changes are located at entrances on either end of Sixth Street, as well as three locations on Central Avenue. Please see the exhibit field map on Page 37.

Handicapped parking: Located at the edge of the exhibit field in the North Parking Lot.

Golf car rental: Cars will be available on a first-come, first-serve basis. You can also reserve a car in advance by calling M&M Golf Cars at 800-748-7798 or 573-581-8188.

Security: Security is provided for our visitors and exhibitors. These uniformed individuals will ensure your safety and the exhibits'. Individuals found to be in violation of laws or vandalizing exhibits will be prosecuted.

Parking: Parking for all vehicles is located adjacent to the show site identified by different colors. Remember the color of the lot where you park. It will make locating your vehicle a lot easier at the end of the day. Farm Progress Companies is not responsible for damage to vehicles.

Food and beverages: Food and beverages are offered for sale at the food courts located throughout the grounds.

Admission and show times: Admission is \$10 for adults, \$5 ages 13-17, 12 and under are free. Adult ticket discounts available at the gate.

Show times for events are listed in the Schedule of Events on Page 35.

Show hours are 8 a.m. to 5 p.m. on Tuesday and Wednesday, and 8 a.m. to 4 p.m. on Thursday.

Transportation: Trams to and from corn harvest and tillage demonstrations will run from 10 a.m. to 3 p.m. Trams will load on the north end of show grounds. See map on Page 37.

Safety: For your safety while on the trams, please keep your hands, arms and legs inside the tram at all times. Adults should accompany young children.
